2020 Fall Sports Spectator Guidelines

The Northern 10 Athletic Conference has developed strict guidelines to adhere to the Governor's order for spectator capacity. Colonel Crawford Junior High Volleyball games will be played in High School Gym when 7th and 8th grade play on same night for home games.

Colonel Crawford will be following the N10 Conference guidelines for all home athletic events as well. The Colonel Crawford marching band will be participating at Varsity Home Football games only and each band member will be given 2 permits to allow their family to purchase 2 tickets at each Varsity home football game.

The Northern 10 Conference would like to thank all fans for their patience, understanding and cooperation. The following health and attendance guidelines are based on requirements set forth by the Ohio Department of Health and our local school districts.

All are subject to change pending future orders from health and school officials.

HEALTH GUIDELINES

Please be a responsible spectator and self-monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 symptoms If you have any, or are just not feeling well, help protect our athletes and remain at home.

Spectators and workers for both indoor and outdoor event must:

wear a face covering at all times indoors/outdoors.

respect social distancing if not from the same family/household

TICKET AVAILABILITY

EVERY SPECTATOR MUST HAVE A 'PERMIT' FROM A MEMBER SCHOOL TO PURCHASE A TICKET AT THE GATES AT ALL N10 CONTESTS.

These permits will be only issued to the athletes, cheerleaders and band members prior to the start of the N10 Season. Lost/stolen permits will not be replaced.

- <u>Varsity Football</u>: Each athlete/cheerleader will receive TWO (2) permits that will allow family members to purchase one ticket per permit at both home and away games.
 Band members will receive TWO (2) but for home games only. Gates will open at 5:30PM.
 - Varsity/JV/FR Volleyball: Each athlete will receive FOUR (4) permits that will allow family members to purchase one ticket per permit at the gates the night of the game.
 All doors will open 45 minutes before first contest of the night.
- JV, FR and JH Football and JH Volleyball: Each athlete will receive FOUR (4) permits that will
 allow family members to purchase one ticket per permit at the gates the day of the game.
 - Non-Conference Games: Guidelines for non-conference games will be established by schools in the contest and announced by each school prior to the event.

All Varsity Tickets (including any HS VB match) – \$6.00
All Sub Varsity Events excluding JV/9th volleyball - \$4.00
Correct change while purchasing tickets is appreciated
Every person regardless of age must have a permit to purchase a ticket
and will be required to purchase a ticket to enter.

Due to capacity limitations, some venues may require 'split-sessions' for volleyball.

Colonel Crawford Covid Plan for Athletic Events

The Ohio Department of Health Order has developed 15% capacity of fixed seating for spectators at athletic Events.

CC Football Field- 2550 Capacity

383 Permitted Spectators at 15%

CC HS Gym- 1200 Capacity

180 Permitted Spectators at 15%

CC ЛІ Gym- 500 Capacity

75 Permitted Spectators at 15%

- 1) Tickets or vouchers will be distributed directly to the athletes to distribute to their families in advance. This will be the same for the home and visiting teams.
- 2) No General Public tickets will be sold
- 3) No Senior of Family Passes will be accepted
- 4) Everyone will be required to wear a mask as they enter the facility and to keep it on until they exit the facility. Only exceptions will be for reasons that are previously approved by the ODH.
- 5) We will have an adult at each entrance to monitor the attendance and take tickets/vouchers
- 6) Guidelines will be used for ALL levels of competition
- 7) Mask guidelines will be strictly followed for players, coaches, trainers, game personnel, etc.as defined in the ODH guidelines.
- 8) We will use only 1 gate of entrance with the exception of Varsity Football. For varsity football we will use 2 gates to maintain a separation of spectators.
- Social distancing will be required. Families are to sit together. Bleachers will all be marked off where spectators should sit.
- 10) Signage will be at all entrances regarding mask wearing, social distancing, etc. Signs will also be placed throughout the facility as much as possible.

- 11) All guidelines for sanitation will be used on equipment and coaches will follow all guidelines that are assign by the Governor/ODH.
- 12) Concession attendants will be following all health guidelines, will wear masks at all times, and will wear gloves whenever handling any food. They have been informed to have wait lines social distanced as well. Pre-packaged food has been recommended.
- 13) Teams and officials will be required to follow social distance and masks policies assigned by the ODH/Governor.
